**Sub : Guidelines for engagement of the AYUSH doctors in the Gram Panchayat Level Dispensary under NRHM.**

Sir,

This is to refer to memo.no.8356/(32)RD/PH&S/PH/2F-3/08 dated 21.12.09 of Panchayat & Rural Development Department and to inform you that on receipt of the status of curative service not available in the Gram Panchayats of your district, an advertisement will be published in the newspaper by this Department mentioning the terms and conditions inviting applications from the intending candidates for engagement of **AYUSH** doctors in the dispensaries to be opened at the Gram Panchayats in which no curative system is available at present. In response to such advertisement, the applications will be received by the B.D.O and ex officio Executive Officer of the respective Panchayat Samity. This guideline is applicable for Ayush doctors to be engaged from funds to be provided under NRHM only.

2) A selection Committee consisting of the Block Dev. Officer, BMO(H), Sabhapati of the Panchayat Samity, Karmadhyaksha, Janaswsthya O Paribesh Sthayee Samity of the concerned Panchayat Samity and the Pradhan of the concerned Gram Panchayat will select the AYUSH Doctor. An AYUSH Doctor shall be deputed by the CMOH of the district as expert to such committee on the request of Block Development Officer.

3) The constitution of the Selection Committee will be as detailed below:

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- 4) The applications received daily shall be entered into a register recording the name of the candidate, address, date of birth and qualification in the given format.

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- 5) At the close of receiving time the applications shall be sorted out. The applications of the GP area will be considered first. If any candidate is available with qualifications mentioned hereunder, he will be selected. If there is more than one candidate from the GP, selection will be made on the basis of higher qualification. If there is more than one candidate having same qualification, percentage of marks obtained by the candidates in different examinations may be taken into account. Then selection will be made through interview.

6) If no candidate is available from the GP, then candidates from the Block area shall be considered and selection will be made observing procedure as stated in the preceding para.

7) If no candidate is available in the Block area, candidates from the Sub-Division will be considered following the same procedure. Candidates from other area of the district will only be considered in case of non-availability of applicant in the sub-division area.

- 8) For selection of the candidates total marks of 50 will be distributed as follow:

- i) Academic & professional records-45

The above number will be allocated in the following way:

- a) Higher Secondary-10  
b) Diploma-10  
c) Bachelor's Degree-15  
d) Post Graduation Degree-20

[The number shown against each examination indicate the maximum-and each candidate may be given number according to the same percentage as has been obtained by him / her in the Academic & Professional examinations passed.]

- ii) Viva Voce -05

- 9) The entire process of selection shall be recorded in writing and attendance of Candidates, if called for interview, should form part of the record.

- 10) Qualifications & other eligibility required:-

a) Age: Not more than 50 years on the 1<sup>st</sup> January of the year of publication of notice, upper age limit is relaxable for 5 years for SC/ST candidates. The agreement between the doctor and the Pradhan will terminate on the date on which the doctor attains the age of 65 years.



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b) Educational qualification:

i) For **Homoeopathy:-**

A Post Graduate degree (MD), a Graduate (BHMS) or a Diploma (DMS/DHMS) in Homoeopathy from an Institution recognized by Central Council of Homoeopathy and must be registered with State or Central Council of Homoeopathy.

ii) For **Ayurveda:-**

A degree in Ayurveda from recognized Institution established by law or Statutory Faculty/Examining Body of Indian Medicine or its equivalent as recognized under Indian Central Council Act, 1970. Candidate must be registered with Paschim Banga Ayurveda Parishad, WB.

iii) For **Unani:-**

Bachelor of Unani Medicine or an Equivalent Degree from a recognized University or Institution and also recognized by the Central Council of Indian Medicine. Candidate must be registered with State Council of Unani Medicine.

11. The Committee will prepare a list of candidates in order of merit for each Gram Panchayat and get such list of candidates approved in the next meeting of the Janaswasthya O Paribesh Sthayee Samity of the concerned Panchayat Samity and send the name of the 1<sup>st</sup> candidate to the Zilla Parishad for approval.

12. The Janaswasthya O Paribesh Sthayee Samity of the Zilla Parishad will take a resolution recommending the names of all such candidates to Panchayat & Rural Development Department. A copy of such resolution alongwith a copy of School Final Certificate, age proof certificate, Professional Certificate & copy of Registration Certificate under the respective Council/Parishad as mentioned in 9(b) (i), (ii), (iii) of the selected candidate should be sent to Panchayats & Rural Development Department for approval.

13. The Panchayat & Rural Development Department will accord approval to such proposals received with a copy of the resolution of Janaswasthya -O- Paribesh Sthayee Samity of the respective Zilla Parishad.

14. On receiving approval of the Panchayat & Rural Development Department, the respective Zilla Parishad will communicate the same to the Panchayat Samity and Gram Panchayat concerned and the Pradhan of the Gram Panchayat will enter into an agreement with the approved candidate in the prescribed proforma circulated vide P & R. D. Department memo.no.6529/RD/PH & S/PH/2M-3/2008 dt.6.10.2009 and engage him on contractual basis for a period of 1 year from the date of entering into the agreement. If the approved candidate refuses to join or resigns after joining, then the selection Committee will consider 2<sup>nd</sup> candidate from the list for engagement and a resolution may be taken in the Janaswasthya O Paribesh Sthayee Samity of the concerned Panchayat Samity recommending the name of the 2<sup>nd</sup> candidate and so on.

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15. All such engagements will be purely on part time and daily remuneration basis. The daily rate of remuneration per day will be fixed by the Health & FW department. At present the rate of remuneration per day is Rs.400/-.

16. The doctors so engaged will have to attend the AYUSH dispensary 4 hours a day and 5 days in a week.

You are requested to inform the Block Development Officer & Ex -officio Executive Officers of the concerned Panchayat Samities about the Selection procedure and the steps to be taken from their end.

Notification cum Guideline for recruitment  
of State Budget aided Gram Panchayat level part-time doctors

Selection procedure of the State Budget aided Gram Panchayat level part-time Homoeopathic and Ayurvedic doctors were being guided by the Order no H/AUH/379/3H-270/85 I dated 23.05.1988 and HF/O/ISMH/118/1A-10/2006 dated 24.02.2006 from long time past. The same have become almost impertinent in respect of the present situation and need to be modified. The matter was under consideration of this Department and now after careful consideration of the whole matter, this Department has decided to amend the guidelines in consultation with the Finance and Health & Family Welfare Department, Govt. of West Bengal for engagement of part-time Homoeopathic and Ayurvedic Medical Officers in Gram Panchayat level dispensaries under State Budget aided in the following manner:

1. Qualifications & other eligibility required:

A. Educational qualification: Higher Secondary examination, certified by 'West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education' or its equivalent is the minimum educational qualification.

B. Professional qualification:

I. For Homoeopathy :

A Bachelor Degree (BHMS) in Homoeopathy from a recognized University or Institution recognized by Central Council of Homoeopathy and must be registered with State or Central Council of Homoeopathy.

II. For Ayurveda :

A Bachelor Degree (BAMS) in Ayurveda from a University or its equivalent as recognized under the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970. Candidate must be registered with 'Paschim Banga Ayurveda Parishad', West Bengal.

At the time of submitting application, all candidates must be registered with proper Council/Parishad and have to submit the registration certificate. Provisional certificate from the same authority can also be entertained but he/she have to produce the original registration certificate within Six months of his/her selection. In anyway, late submission of Registration Certificate will not be entertained.

C. Age: Entry age for part-time Homoeopathic/Ayurvedic Medical Officer in Gram Panchayat dispensaries shall be not more than 50 years and exit age shall be 65 years.



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Age should be calculated on 1<sup>st</sup> January of the Publication of recruitment notification. Entry age limit is relaxable for 5 years for SC/ST and 3 years for OBC candidates.

- D. Language known: Candidate must have knowledge in Bengali both speaking and writing.
- E. Candidate must be a citizen of India.
- F. Papers to be submitted with prescribed application form(Annexure-I):
1. Admit Card/Certificate of Secondary examination or equivalent or Birth Certificate issued by proper Government authority as age proof document.
  2. Mark Sheets as in certificates for professional qualification.
  3. Any Three of the EPIC, AADHAR, PAN, Ration card, Passport, Bank Pass Book, Certificate of address having photo issued by 'Member of Parliament' or 'Member of Legislative Assembly' or Group 'A' Gazetted Officer on proper letter head, Household Utility bill (Gas, Electric, Water, fixed Land line) showing name and current address (not more than three months old), Property/ Wealth tax assessment certificate with same details as address proof cum identity proof.
  4. Self Declaration of same present and permanent address (if any).
  5. Medical Registration Certificate.
  6. Caste Certificate where applicable.

Selection procedure

2. A Selection Committee consisting of the Block Development Officer(B.D.O), Block Medical Officer of Health (B.M.O.H), Sabhapati of the Panchayat Samity concerned, Karmadhyaksha (Janaswsthya-O-Paribesh Sthayee Samity of the Panchayat Samity concerned), One Medical Officer shall be deputed by the Chief Medical Officer of Health (C.M.O.H) of the district as expert to such committee at the request of Block Development Officer along with the Assistant Chief Medical of Health (A.C.M.O.H) and the Prodhan of the Gram Panchayat concerned will select the candidate. The constitution of the Selection Committee will be as detailed below:

3. An advertisement will be published in at least two widely circulated newspapers by the Zilla Parishad concerned mentioning the terms and conditions inviting applications from the intending candidates for the engagement of part-time Medical Officers in the sanctioned dispensaries at the Gram Panchayats. In response to such advertisement, the applications will be received by the Block Development Officer and Ex-officio Executive Officer of the respective Panchayat Samity. The Zilla Parishad should publish an advertisement, even for one vacancy.
4. Recruitment shall be done in those Gram Panchayats only where no other Govt. aided Medical facilities exist.
5. For selection of the candidates total marks 60 (sixty) will be distributed as follows :-

- A. Academic & professional qualifications – 45

The above number will be allocated in the following way:

- I. Academic : Higher Secondary – 10

II. Professional :

- (i) Bachelor's Degree (BHMS/BAMS) – 30

- (ii) Post Graduation Degree (MD) – 5 (not based on mark sheets, only certificate)

- B. Others (residing in GP concerned) – 5

(For Academic and Professional qualification a candidate may be given marks on percentage basis against his/her qualification only.

- C. Viva-voce – 10

Final selection will be made adding marks in Academic Qualification, Professional Qualification and Viva-voce taken together.

The entire process of selection shall be recorded in written and attendance of Candidates, if called for interview, should form part of the record. After closing of receiving date, all applications would be sorted out according to the eligibility criteria. A candidate can apply for more than One Gram Panchayat. Interview will be called



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for each post (i.e. for each Gram Panchayat). All eligible candidates should come under interview. Any candidate residing in Gram Panchayat area concerned will get additional 5 marks in the interview. Panel cum merit list should be prepared for each Gram Panchayat. Interview of the candidates for one GP will be held in a single day. Interview dates will be fixed Gram Panchayat wise. All successful candidates should come in to the panel in order of merit for each GP.

6. The Committee will prepare a panel of each successful candidate in order of merit for each Gram Panchayat and get such panel of candidates approved in the next meeting of the Janaswasthya-O-Paribesh Sthayee Samity of the Panchayat Samity concerned and send the panel recommending the name of 1st candidate for engagement to the Zilla Parishad.
7. The Janaswasthya-O-Paribesh Sthayee Samity of the Zilla Parishad shall consider the proposal referred in Para-6 above is in order and will take a resolution recommending the name of 1st candidates to the Panchayat and Rural Development Department for approval. A copy of such resolution alongwith the panel made by the selection committee (if any) and a copy of educational qualification, age proof certificate, residential certificate, Professional Certificate, copy of Registration Certificate under the respective Council/Parishad as mentioned in Para-5(II) i) and ii) of the selected candidate should be sent to the Panchayats and Rural Development Department.
8. The Panchayats and Rural Development Department will consider such proposal and if found in order, will accord approval to such proposals.
9. On receiving approval of the Panchayats and Rural Development Department, the respective Zilla Parishad will communicate the same to the Panchayat Samity and Gram Panchayat concerned and the Prodhan of the Gram Panchayat will enter into an agreement with the approved candidate in the prescribed proforma circulated vide Panchayats and Rural Development Department vide memo no. 534 (18)/RD/PH&S/PH/2M-5/08 dated 31.01.2014 and engage him on part time basis. For the purpose an agreement may be made on specific terms & conditions. If the approved candidate refuses to join or resigns after joining, then the selection committee will consider next candidate from the list for engagement and a resolution may be taken in the Janaswasthya-O-Paribesh Sthayee Samity of the Panchayat Samity concerned recommending the name of the next candidate and so on.



10. The date of joining of the concerned doctor(after signing of the contract paper) must be sent to the Panchayats & Rural Development Department within two months from the date of receiving and the approved candidate must join in his/her post within One month from the date of receiving of appointment letter.
11. Maximum days of absence permissible in a year will be 30. However, they will be entitled honorarium for 12 off days(maximum 08 days in one stretch) only.
12. Validity of the panel is fixed to be of one year from the date of joining of the candidate for the first time from the panel. In case where validity of the panel has expired in accordance with above or where there is no other candidate in the panel, the fresh recruitment process may be initiated as per. Zilla Parishad concerned will advertise for this purpose at least two widely circulated newspapers. Permission for filling up vacancies in such cases no further approval will be required from this end but final approval of the candidate needs to be certified from this Deptt. as usual.
13. Any candidate engaged by any authority without maintaining the prescribed guideline would not be accepted for candidature by this Department.
14. Engagement will be on part time basis up to a maximum of 65 years of age. Terms and conditions will be as per contract. Their honorarium will be fixed by the Health & Family Welfare Department in consultation with Finance Department.
15. The Zilla Parishad, before recommending the selected candidate, must declare the present court case status.
16. The contract between the Pradhan and the selected doctor will be for one time. The work responsibilities, working period, attendance and the terms and conditions for continuation of their service are as laid down in the prescribed Contract proforma (Annexed).

You are requested to inform to the Block Development Officer & Ex-Officio Executive Officer of Panchayat Samities concerned about the selection procedure and the steps to be taken from their end.

কোনো রোগের প্রাদুর্ভাব লক্ষ্য করলে তা গ্রাম পঞ্চায়েতের প্রধানের কাছে লিখিতভাবে জানাবেন।
- ৪) গ্রাম পঞ্চায়েতের সদর স্বাস্থ্য উপকেন্দ্রে চিকিৎসার কাজ করার জন্য শ্রী.....(চিকিৎসক) গ্রাম  
পঞ্চায়েতের কাছ থেকে সরকারি আদেশনামা অনুসারে সাম্মানিক পাবেন এবং ওই চিকিৎসাকেন্দ্রের কাজের দিনগুলির  
অন্তত ৯০ শতাংশ উপস্থিত হয়ে তাঁর দায়িত্ব নির্বাহ করবেন এবং পূর্ব ঘোষণা ব্যতীত কখনই অনুপস্থিত হবেন না।
- ৫) যদি গ্রাম পঞ্চায়েতের প্রধান লক্ষ্য করেন যে চিকিৎসকের আচরণ চিকিৎসাকেন্দ্রে পরিচালনার পরিপন্থী, বিশেষতঃ  
নিম্নবর্ণিত আচার-আচরণগুলির কোনও একটি বা একাধিক যদি তাঁর ক্ষেত্রে পরিলক্ষিত হয়, তাহলে তাঁর (চিকিৎসকের)

চিকিৎসকের উত্তরে সন্তুষ্ট না হলে প্রধান গ্রাম পঞ্চায়েতের অনুমোদন সাপেক্ষে ঐ চুক্তিকালীন যে কোন সময়ে পনেরো দিনের  
নোটিশ দিয়ে তা বাতিল করতে পারেন। যদি গ্রাম পঞ্চায়েতের সভায় সংশ্লিষ্ট চিকিৎসকের চুক্তি নবীকরণ না করানোর সিদ্ধান্ত  
নেওয়া হয়, সংশ্লিষ্ট প্রধান চুক্তি শেষ হওয়ার ১৫দিন আগে ঐ চিকিৎসককে লিখিতভাবে তা জানাবেন। সংশ্লিষ্ট চিকিৎসকও  
চুক্তিকালীন সময়ে গ্রাম পঞ্চায়েতের প্রধানের কাছে পনেরো দিনের নোটিশ দিয়ে পদত্যাগ করতে পারেন।  
গ্রাম পঞ্চায়েতের সিদ্ধান্তে সন্তুষ্ট না হলে সংশ্লিষ্ট চিকিৎসক নোটিশ পাওয়ার থেকে ৭টি কাজের দিনের মধ্যে মহকুমা  
শাসকের কাছে আপীল করতে পারেন। মহকুমা শাসক চূড়ান্ত সিদ্ধান্ত না নেওয়া পর্যন্ত ঐ চিকিৎসক কাজ চালিয়ে যাবেন।
